Painting Ale Bowls David Refsal

Use all Josonja paint, sealers, retarder and varnish.

I 3 coats of sealer

All-purpose sealer Turner's Yellow Mix approximately 1 to 1 ratio. Add water to thin. After 3rd coat dries, sand lightly.

Ш **Painting**

2 light coats, 3 if you want a darker look. Mix and apply and then pad off the high spots with a rag.

1 part paint

3 parts of clear glaze medium 1 part of retarder

Ш **Antiquing**

1 part of clear glaze medium 1 part of retarder 3 parts of dioxazine purple Drop of burnt umber. Add water to thin.

Apply and wipe off. Do not apply this to any white area. Let dry overnight.

I۷ Finish

Apply 3 coats of satin varnish. Let dry between coats.
