We have several ideas already. We have several ideas on what those kits could consist of. Another idea is to mount a large board on the table, have kids write there initials on and then we would help them carve out the initials. This will give them a taste of carving. Recap of the event is that 2,587 kids participated in the activities. There were 50 activities available for kids to participate in. Total attendance was 4,704 attendees. The time was 10 am to 4 pm.
