The largest wood carving in the world is a 40 foot long sculpture carved by a Chinese artist Zheng Chunhui. The sculpture is based on a 900 year old Chinese painting called "Along the River During the Qingming Festival and features intricate details of life in a small town. It took the artist four years to complete the sculpture, which was carved from a single tree trunk. The sculpture was declared the world's largest wood sculpture by the Guinness Book of World Records.

The sad news is that Jim Phillip Smith passed away. Jim took up carving later in life and was a member of Prairie Woodcarvers. Born April 16, 1934 and died October 10, 2023. Jim was married to his wife Jeanette Marie Ireland in 1959. They had four children. Jim was best remembered for his stories. Regardless how unbelievable they were, they were his actual life. Anything you could possibly think of doing in life, Jim had already done it.

HE WILL BE MISSED


We will be carving walking sticks out of diamond willow on November 11 and 12th. Hope to see a lot of you.
